

**MADISON USBC WOMEN'S BOWLING ASSOCIATION
HALL OF FAME – 2016**

DORIS ANDERSON, member of Madison WBA, is inducted into the MWBA Hall of Fame in the Superior Performance category in August 2016.

Doris has been a member of MWBA for 42 years, bowling in various leagues including the Holy Ballers league and All Star Co-Ed league at Village Lanes and the OM Fine Products league at Bowl-A-Vard Lanes.

In 2011, Doris as part of the Strike Zone team, posted her first local MWBA championship tournament win. The Strike Zone team had a scratch score of 2,470 and a handicap score of 2,726 to take both the scratch and handicap titles in the 4-person Team Division. More recently, Doris took first place in the 2016 MWBA Queen's Tournament.

Along with her championship wins, Doris placed 2nd in the 2012-2013 MWBA Senior Tournament with a handicap score of 713 in the 50-59 age group and has 3rd place finishes in the 2012-2013 MWBA Championship Tournament in both the Doubles and Team events and in the 2007-2008 MWBA Queen's Tournament.

Doris has bowled a career high game of 300 and a career high series of 780. In addition, she posted a career high average in the 2012-2013 season of 211 for 48 games in the Holy Ballers League. Doris has consistently maintained an average over 195 in multiple leagues since the 2011-2012 season.

Doris is always striving to be her best on the lanes, but is also willing to help other bowlers with tips and encouragement.
