HALL OF FAME – 2001

KAY MINTER, member of Madison WBA, is inducted into the MWBA Hall of Fame in the Meritorious Service category in August 2001.

Kay has been a member of MWBA for 37 years and during that time served on the MWBA Board of Directors for 21 years; 17 as a Director and 4 years as its President.

During her tenure as MWBA President, Kay served as Ex Officio on all committees with the exception of Nominating Committee. As a Director, Kay served many years as Chairperson of the Finance Committee and the Audit Committee as well as YABA representative. She also served her association as an MWBA tournament worker for 20 years and has competed in 33 MWBA Championship Tournaments. Kay served as Doubles & Singles Office Chair during the 1997 WWBA Tournament in Madison.

As a delegate, Kay has represented MWBA at 10 WIBC Annual Meetings and for one year at the WWBA Annual Meeting. As a participant, Kay has bowled in 29 WIBC Championship Tournaments and 18 WWBA Championship Tournaments.

Kay Minter served in other areas of the sport of bowling such as Secretary of Madison Bowling Council for 2 years, President of Madison 600 Club for 4 years and as Secretary in three bowling leagues; however, her great love was the Junior Bowling Association and its program. She served them in many capacities for 21 years not only locally but on the state level as well.

During her bowling career, Kay credits a 256 as her high game, a high series of 637 and a career high average of 184.

Kay Minter set goals and ideals that have always been in the interests of the game of bowling and has seen the results of her efforts in the young people that have come to enjoy this sport.
