### **HALL OF FAME – 2004**

**LISA KOLOSSO**, member of Madison WBA is inducted into the Madison WBA Hall of Fame in the Superior Performance category in August 2004.

Lisa has been a member of MWBA for 22 years and a sanctioned bowler since 1965. She has a career high 3-game series of 784 and has career high games of two 300's as well as a 299, 298, and a 297. To her credit, Lisa has a career high average of 209 and has maintained an average in the 200's for many years.

During her 22 years as a MWBA member, Lisa has competed in 14 of the Association's Championship Tournaments; compiling high scratch scores of 2850 and 3317 in 1993-94 and 1994-95 during two Team Events with Jess' Pro Shop Team and winning scratch and handicap of 3397 in Division 1 with Keglars in 1995-96. The Doubles Events in 1986-87 found Lisa in first place with a personal best of 713. In 1988-89 Lisa captured first place honors in the scratch Class A All-Events with a 638 high series and 1841 overall; both of which earned her that tournament's Past President's Trophy as well as the President's Award.

The 1997-98 season found Lisa and her Kegler's Team on top of their game, winning 1<sup>st</sup> place in the WWBA Championship Tournament with 2917 and 1<sup>st</sup> place in the WIBC Championship Tournament with 2756.

Lisa participated in the WWBA Queen's Tournament in Appleton in 1994. She was a member of the 1989 Capitol Times all-area women's team and she also bowled the WHA Tournament where she made the TV Match Play at least 3 times and made it once to the winner's circle.

Lisa is also proud of the fact she has helped with fund raising for Big Brothers/Big Sisters Organization.

Lisa brings the true meaning of sportsmanship to the sport of bowling through her love of the game, performance, and competitive spirit.
