

MADISON USBC WOMEN'S BOWLING ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME

Mona Peirce is inducted into the MWBA Hall of Fame in the Superior Performance category in August 2007.

Mona has been a sanctioned bowler and a member of the MWBA for more than 25 years.

Early in Mona's bowling career she posted averages of 139 and 147. Four years later she had raised that average to the 170s and a few years later consistently carried averages in the 180s.

In 1999 Mona won our association's championship tournament Division #1 Singles Handicapped with a score of 787 and Division #1 Scratch with 669. That year she also took the Division #1 All Events titles when she posted a handicapped total of 2214 and scratch total of 1860. Mona topped off a great tournament year by posting the tournament high game of 279.

Mona didn't let the successes of 1999 overwhelm her. In 2000 she posted her high series of 715 and posted her high final average of 190. And in 2001 Mona bowled on the Village Rollers team when they won our association championship tournament's Division 3 Handicapped and Scratch titles.

Mona has bowled in over 15 WWBA State tournaments and she took center stage in 2003 when she placed second in Division 2 Singles and walked away with the All Events title.

Mona's skills on the lanes earn her the honor of being our newest Hall of Fame inductee. However, there is much more to be said. Mona has worked in bowling centers for over 25 years and has been an operations manager for the past 19 years. Mona has served on the board of directors of the Madison Women's Bowling Association for 10 years and has been active as an administrator and coach in the area's junior bowling program. Her enthusiasm for bowling is endless as she continues to serve Madison area bowlers, assisting secretaries, coordinating adult leagues and making new bowlers feel welcome. In our bowling community Mona's a skilled bowler, a business woman, a volunteer, a role model and a true friend of our sport!
