Awarded scholarship(s) will be paid after the successful completion of one (1) semester as a full-time student at an accredited post-secondary educational institution with proof of grades and proof of 2nd semester registration.

Scholarship monies awarded will be deposited directly into the students SMART account, if the student does not have a SMART account the monies will go directly to the school of students choice.

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Funding

The scholarship will be primarily funded thru a 50/50 raffle to be held at the Jamboree and city tournament.

In addition, initial start up money will consist of the interest earned on the \$50,000 CD at the Monona Grove State Bank, due to mature in March of 2007 – with this money to be considered eligible for scholarship distribution. Plus, 2 CDs – 1 from Monona Grove State Bank of approximately \$3,000 due to mature on 9/27/2007 and 1 from Greater Wisconsin Credit Union of approximately \$7,000 due to mature on 11/03/2007 – at time of maturity will be cashed in and reinvested as a combined amount. The initial investment principal will be considered as MWBA available funds, but all subsequent earnings on this investment will be contributed as ongoing funding for the scholarship.

Scholarship Selection

The scholarship committee as appointed by the president will make the award selection based on the received and completed applications.

The selection will then be approved by board of directors and ex-officio.

The scholarship will be award to at least 1 applicant and consist of at least \$500.00 with additional scholarships awarded or the amount adjusted based on available funds.
